#### **Conservation Report**

Historic Gravestone Services (HGS) visited the site early in 2022 to review the condition and photograph the selected stones. A total of 46 gravestones were selected based on their existing conditions and need of preservation. HGS began work in May and completed the work in November 2022.

All stones were photographed and transcribed before work began. HGS carefully excavated the stones and screened the dirt for fragments. The stones were cleaned with water using a soft bristle brush, then treated with D2, a biocide and rinsed thoroughly. Several stones were simple resets and were excavated, cleaned & reset with a sand/gravel mix to help with water drainage.

Broken stones were cleaned and treated as described above before any repairs. Any epoxy or concrete residues were removed and the contact areas cleaned with denatured alcohol. All broken stones were assembled without epoxy which can fail due to moisture build up around the epoxy, therefore Jahn restoration mortar was used to cement as well as fill voids. Jahn Restoration Mortar is a non-shrinking porous mortar that reacts similar to the effects of weather and moisture as natural stone allowing for a longer lasting repair.

Fallen tablet markers missing material sufficient to reset as a tablet were set into a slotthrough concrete base created off-site and specific to each stone. The tablet was cleaned and treated as described above. The base was set plumb just below grade and the stone set with a high lime mortar. Top soil and sod were replaced to conceal the concrete base.

Upon completion, all the stones were photographed and detailed condition reports for each stone were compiled including condition, treatments, materials used for preservation, name, date of death, stone type and inscription if legible. All work was performed in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and American Institute of Conservators code of ethics.
