Muir Meadow

- BOS discussed the issues relating to the Site Approval Application for the Muir Meadow (off Pleasant St)
- (FG) & (MQ) provided a list of their concerns (attached).
- (WT) stating he was in agreement and that he is totally against the size of the project and questioned whether the contractor could be asked to come back before them to answer questions. (FG) responded that the BOS need to get a letter out on this to MassHousing. (WT) stated that he did not believe the Fire Dept. have the capacity to dealt with a multi dwelling fire.
- **Motion (MQ) seconded (FG) for (WT) to write the letter to MassHousing to include the points they have raised and include a copy of the zoning bylaw section pertaining to affordable housing. Unanimous all in favor.**

- (FG) asked that BOS sign a letter addressed to Teresa Cauldwell, copied to Mass Land Court to state that
- *“The Kiyi Trail Road (map 9) was a proposed road (paper street) that would intersect with Turkey Hill Road, Paxton then proceed to a left hand turn into Rutland.*

- *There is no record that this road was ever developed nor was there any request, indication to change or alter the plan or proposed road since it's inception in 1925".*

Motion (FG) seconded (WT) to send letter. Unanimous all in favor.

Ethic Commission – mandate

- **Motion (MQ) seconded (FG) to ask (CB) to send a letter to the State Auditor similar to the ones written by Westborough and Ashland objecting to this unfunded state mandate. Unanimous all in favor.**
