Review budget items

- (CR) Article #1 now reflects a reduction from EMS and on article #2 we need to vote the 1st figure because the initial vote failed.
- (PB) Did Town Counsel review this?
- (CR) No, but we have already presented our numbers and they failed.
- (CR) There are only three articles to act on tonight. 1, 2, 3, 7 and 10 were passed over last meeting, but we will still hold off on 7 and 10.
- (JP) Carol will talk to the Department Heads about watching budgets until the school budget is settled.

Make recommendation on warrant articles

- (JM) We will not accept a higher number for the school without a proposition 2 ¹/₂. If there is any extra money from the school over the \$120,000 it would go into surplus levy.

- **Town Accountant** Donna Couture stated that we are just appropriating the bottom line for the school budget, and not a line item budget.
- Scott Runstrom from the Finance Committee expressed that we need a motion to reopen article #2
