Over the past 10 years there have been discussions regarding the renovation of the Town Hall but due to funding, nothing has progressed and nor do I see anything happening in the near future.

The current building still has many years of useful life and Town Hall employees have done their best to make the interior as pleasant as possible to the extent of completing the painting the foyer in their own time. We have also utilized the students of Baypath Vocational School to renovate the two bathrooms; the first improvements in over 15 years.

Being in the center of the Town, the Town Hall in the condition that it is today is a disgrace to the Town and we owe it to residents to take pride in what we own and repaint this building and encapsulate the lead contents. The project is many years overdue!

Town Hall Painting:

- The Town Hall is the focal point of the Town Center and the condition of the exterior paint is a disgrace.
- Initial tests indicate the presence of lead that will require removal by a licensed professional.
- There are no current plans to fund the renovation of the building and it still has many useful years of life.

- Initial tests indicate presence of lead.



4. Lead found to be present on existing coating after being tested with a child swab test. Further testing may be advised by the town before starting work. Cole painting will have to follow current Lead RRP Laws which includes the following. Competent foreman to be a lead certified renovator. All paint chips to be safely contained and disposed of properly. Entire site will have to posted that lead is present.

Carol we are not lead abatement company. we have guys who are certified lead renovators. We follow current laws to contain chips and dispose of properly. Also we make sure all workers are completely protected while working.

Lead abatement companies come in and remove any substrate that has lead in it. We price the job to encapsulate existing lead. That's why the town may want to do further testing to see if you require abatement. If you don't you could use our method.

However to answer your question I would say I added 6 or 7 thousand for protection, posting, and proper disposal of chips.
