New Business – Budget for FY23	(TT) has been tracking actual costs of payroll hours and materials for the cemeteries, and notes that, modestly, the budget should be around \$39,000 for the fiscal year. Presently, the budget is at \$12,607. (CS) noted that the Cemetery budget has not been increased in roughly a decade.	The Commission agreed to have (TT) speak with the Town Administrator and the Finance Committee to see if there is any chance of increasing the FY23 Cemetery budget, even to a small degree.
New Business – Cemetery walk collaboration with Historical Commission	(JM) has been in touch with the Historical Commission about a potential walk/tour of the Center Cemetery, including the portrayal of a few of the individuals interred there. HC has proposed the weekend of Patriots Day in 2023.	The Commission agreed to the weekend of Patriots Day 2023, and to have (JM) schedule a joint meeting with HC and CC to discuss the endeavor further.
