Request for Certificate of Compliance: 16 South Street, by owner, Jason Burgess. Letter received from Quinn Engineering stating changes from approved plan and that stormwater system is fully functioning. Site visit complete. The Commission discussed and a TL motioned, BF seconded to issue a certificate of compliance.

Informal Discussion:

7 Indian Hill Road – Owner Mike Capurso present to discuss the site. Mr. Capurso had been working with Chris Keenan as a commissioner to fix the previous disturbances on the site. He was directed to rebuild the stream channel and stabilize with stone. The order of condition requires hedge or vegetative buffer along the edge of the stream to prevent encroaching. Mr. Capurso suggested ferns and the Commission stated that the vegetation should be a woody-type shrub or bush to prevent mowing. The Commission required the removal of the rocks in the stream channel at the edge of the property. Mr. Capurso stated that they would be removed within a week. Commissioners TL agreed to meet on the site on August 18 to go over requirements.


