


Paxton Conservation Commission

- Jim Robert will visit 11 Walnut Street.
- Holly Robert gave an update on the Asnebumskit Trail project. She attended the Dec 16 meeting at the Greater Worcester Land Trust and made the following observations:
 - a trail from South Street, Holden, might join up with the trail, other possible extensions exist that would make it part of an extensive system.
 - O Paxton's Open Space Plan needs to be rewritten for us to be eligible for grant money needed to buy the necessary parcels of land.
 - o Residents abutting the proposed trail were present at the meeting, all seemed to be in favor of the proposals.
 - Former PCC member and current Open Space Committee member Robert Bertin was also present and offered to help delineate wetlands on the existing PCC parcel.
 - O The best access point for the trail remains uncertain due to possible wetlands in the area.

The next meeting of the Commission will be held on Thursday, February 10 at 7:30 PM.
