The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:31pm.

Darryll McCall introduced WRSD officials Joe Scanlon and Jeff Carlson

- January 11<sup>th</sup> was the School Committee retreat 3 priorities
- Enrollment is expected to level off to 7,000 students

#### **Salaries**

- Unrepresented replaced staff were less paid then new employees
- Substitutes under budget FY14 FY15 restored.
- Large influx of student at High School

Reducing three classroom teachers at the elementary level ELL teachers – none at the moment 2 ELL teachers needed Chapter 70 lower due to less students Charge backs - corrected against grants

Health Insurance Blue Cross PPO – 50/50 90/10

Active 80/20

Non med 90/10 - Blue Cross

80/20 – Medex 50/50 – Med

New hires and administration - 80/20

- Part of the contract
- Attendance taken
- Technology 5 year plan
- All new copiers print management contract
- Cost analysis E books vs books. Nota able to do as of yet not purchased a full series of books

#### **Operations and Maintenance**

- 9.6% increase
- 30% custodial nothing in FY13. Over budget FY14 restoring

#### **Special Education**

- Providing more support within the schools rather than sending to other facilities.
- Decreasing \$175,901 8.4%
- Administrative estimates \$60,000 but no other impact
- Pothole a/c applied to for cost of administrative work.
- Other operational costs decreased.

### **Transportation**

- \$406,262 7.6% increase due to Atlantic Express bankruptcy.
- AA new bus service 3 year contract
  - o FY16 7.3 and FY 17 6.3
  - o 47 new buses
  - o 49 village buses

#### **Debt Services**

- MLC higher student enrollment
- FY14 717 104 8.1%
- 726 195 9.42%
- Oil re. \$9,672 \$237,221 debt excluded
- Transportation aid will reduce asst.
- Included in transportation due to bankrupt bus company
- \$400,000 increase
- 80% increase requested by:
