Town Clerk - Deirdre Malone

- (JM) recused himself.
- Discussed the need to relocate the polling site from the Paxton Center School. Nothing
 can be done for this year's elections, but at a future time this should be addressed in the
 presence of the Police Chief.
- The Town Clerk provided a salary survey for both her own and the Assistants position. The
 Town Clerk believes that this position should be full time (37 hours). The State System has
 created an increase in work for this position. She is also requesting an increase in the
 hourly pay rate for the Assistant Town Clerk.
- (FG) stated that the PAB should conduct a full review of the position to establish the full extend of the responsibilities of the Town Clerk, and compare this with the job description and the duties of other Town Clerks included in the survey.

<u>Town Treasurer – Deirdre Malone</u>

- Town Treasurer provided new borrowing documents in the amount of \$128,000 for the BOS to sign to reauthorize the borrowing for the Sweeper.
