Drop off at Light Dept.



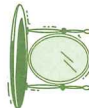
### Christmas Trees

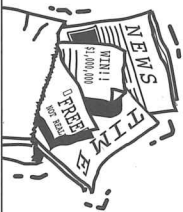

# 2019-2020 Paxton Recycling Info

For all Residents and Businesses with Municipal Trash Collection

## RECYCLING IS MANDATORY

### Paper



Place in bin at curbside during Paper Collection Week (highlighted in blue on calendar below)

- Newspaper with inserts
- Magazines, catalogs and phone books
- Junk mail, office paper and paper bags
- Paperboard (e.g. cereal boxes)
- Corrugated cardboard flattened to 2 ft. x 2 ft.
- No soiled paper (e.g. food wrappers, pizza boxes)

### Containers



Rinse and place in bin at curbside during Container Collection Week (highlighted in green on calendar below)

- Glass bottles/jars—remove lids, corks, neck rings, etc. No broken or other glass such as light bulbs, window or auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex.
- Tin, steel and aluminum food cans & lids, deposit & non-deposit beverage cans and aluminum foil—may flatten. No cans containing hazardous material, paint or aerosol.
- Milk & juice cartons, drink boxes, plastic containers labeled  -  -may flatten. No plastic bags.

## 2019-2020 Collection Calendar

### Trash and Recycling Collection Instructions

Items must be at the curb by 7 am on collection day. Recycling bins are collected Monday through Thursday. Look for your street listed on the back panel to find your collection day.

Paper and container bins are collected on alternate weeks. Paper is collected during weeks highlighted in GREY on the calendar below. Containers are collected during weeks highlighted in GREEN.

If you forget to put your trash and recycling out, the hauler will not come back to get it.

### Holiday Schedule

During a Holiday week, from the holiday on, everything gets picked up one day later in the week.

Recycling collection days are affected by 5 Holidays:

- Monday, Sept 2, 2019 • Thursday, Nov 28, 2019 • Wednesday, Dec 25, 2019
  - Wednesday, Jan 1, 2020 • Monday, May 25, 2020
- The 5 holidays observed are circled below.
