

2022 DOG LICENSES PLEASE REGISTER NOW!

Massachusetts General Law Chapter 140 Section 137 requires all dogs over the age of six months to be licensed. Now is the time to renew your license. You may renew online (<http://epay.cityhallsystems.com>) using the name on the rabies certificate as owner, by mail (use form below) or by phone (508-799-7347 ext 13). Current rabies certificates must be on file in the Town Clerk's office before licenses can be issued. Licenses must be renewed before April 1st to avoid late fees and fines. Please notify the Town Clerk if your dog has passed or moved.

Unaltered Male/Female dogs - \$15.00 Neutered/Spayed dogs - \$10.00
Owner (as listed on the rabies certificate) 70 years of age or older – No charge

Note: Prior year balances & Animal Control Officer Fines must be paid in full – please call the Town Clerk if you are uncertain if you have outstanding balances.
