## **Meeting Minutes**

• Motion (JM) seconded (RJ) to accept the meeting minutes of June 12, 2014.

### Paul Robinson Re 662 Pleasant St

• Paul Robinson requested that the Board give some water rate relief for multi-family homes. His calculation (per document attached) shows that he will be expected to pay an additional \$240 a year. He suggested either giving a commercial rate or double allowance of the first rate.

The Board discussed the following in this regard:

- Received quotes for new meters:
  - 2"MVR = \$782
  - 3"MVR = \$1495
- These will be ordered and installed.

### **PCS New Meters**

• The meters were installed at PCS and the readings show an increase over previous records of at three times.

# Michael Putnam, DPW & Water Superintendent

- (MP) gave his monthly update of the FY14 accounts.
- Will be acquiring a new hand held unit as current one is going out of service, upgrading from a FC200 to FC300 which will include docking station, mica light. No training will be required and if there is a problem at any time with the unit a temporary replacement will be overnighted. Cost will be shared with the Light Dept. and will be \$2970 for each dept.

### **Maple Water Tank Update**

- Received specs from Tata & Howard and are currently reviewing these. Need more
  clarification on what is actually included in the SRF loan request as the amount may not be
  sufficient.
- Already advised that the cost of transferring the antennas is not included, (MP) and (CR) intend to meet with Mark Cady, IB Communications to get a better idea of the costs.
- T&H pointed out that the current generator will not be sufficient and would require replacing, price to be determined.

### **Travis Thibault, Water Working Foreman**

- (TT) reported bad water samples at three sites. Need to post a message to residents in the press, website and cable.
- Not exactly sure what caused this but there was a water main break discovered on South Street shortly after the bad samples. This was reported by a resident who stated that she could smell bleach (chlorine).
- There was also a further water break this week on Crystal Street.

### **Worcester Water Secondary Water Source**

• (MP) DEP is looking for Paxton to release water to Worcester to sell to Leicester as a secondary source. Water Commission is not opposed to the idea and are willing to discuss further on receipt of more communication from Worcester..
